Fundraising, grant proposals, building a network of individual donors: Jaime working on letter to Get Go manager for donations, gift cards, water, towels, hygiene products (uncertain if it will be monthly or quarterly)

Veterans Support Foundation grant due at the end of this month- Naomi is working on it Individual donors- build and nurture relationships, no goals for the board, suggested a strategy meeting for fundraising

Daughters of the Revolution- OSM would like to speak at their organization (possible gift/donation)

May 9th Veterans Breakfast Club- Jaime

PA State Grant DMVA- application is completed, pending, vender number was approved, could be up to \$50,000, the recipients will be announced by the end of March 2018 and funds will be dispersed in June or July 2018

PWC- still pending, our proposal is at the National level, could be between \$50,000-\$100,000, their next board meeting is April 2018

Kim to work on Awesome Pittsburgh (\$1,000 one time grant), and The Sprout Fund **Forward Engagement Teams:** funding, recruit volunteers/administrative assistant, ability to speak to groups of people (to spark interest and train them), get our foot in the door

- FRG's (Family Readiness Groups)

Compensation: Board voted on Tom Stokes- to increase his compensation from ¾ (\$30,000) to full time (\$40,000), in prospective budget, the change resulted from Tom's retirement from the Military on March 1, 2018. Therefore, prospective compensation will go from \$30,000 to \$40,000 annually. Compensation will be reviewed for all staff periodically.
